The reduction in flooding will benefit property owners in the immediate area as well as property owners using Thoronson Road for access.</p> <p>The desired outcome is to limit flooding at the head of the city’s stormsewer system near the intersection of Hwy 51 and Thronson Drive, to limit impacts on structures, and ensure access.</p>
