Standard Response Protocol (SRP) & Standard Reunification Method (SRM) August 1st 8am-4pm

In this course, the Office of School Safety (OSS) will present a model of comprehensive school safety and introduce SRP and SRM. These procedures are practical, action based, responses given to any situation within a school community. The six specific actions performed after an incident include Hold, Secure, Lockdown, Evacuate, Shelter, and Reunify. The SRM is utilized to reunite students with parents and guardians after an emergency or crisis.
